**CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. 1 (*Repealed by Charter Ordinance 4*)**

A CHARTER ORDINANCE EXEMPTING THE CITY OF PAWNEE ROCK, KANSAS FROM THE PROVISIONS OF K.S.A. 15-101 et. seq. PROVIDING FOR THE ELIMINATION OF THE POSITION OF CITY TREASURER AND ASSIGNING TO THE CITY CLERK THE FUNCTIONS PREVIOUSLY PERFORMED BY THE CITY TREASURER

Originally passed and approved by the Governing body on May 3, 2004.

**CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. 2 (*Repealed by Charter Ordinance 5*)**

A CHARTER ORDINANCE EXEPTING THE CITY OF PAWNEE ROCK, KANSES FROM THE OPEN-MEETING PROVISIONS OF K.SA., 15-106, AND PROVIDING SUBSTITUTE PROVISIONS ON THE SAME SUBJECT. BE IT SO CHANGED AND REPEALING ALL OTHER ORDINANCES, AND PARTS OF ORDIANCES, INCONSISTENT OR IN CONFLICT WITH THE TERMS OF THIS ORDINACE.

Originally passed and approved by the Governing body on May 5, 1997.

### CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. 3

A CHARTER ORDINANCE EXEMPTING THE CITY OF PAWNEE ROCK, KANSAS, FROM THE PROVISIONS OF K.S.A. 15-209, PROVIDING SUBSTITUTE AND ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS ON THE SAME SUBJECT AND REMOVING LIMITATIONS ON RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS FOR THE ALL APPOINTED OFFICERS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF PAWNEE ROCK , KANSAS:

Section 1. The City of PAWNEE ROCK, Kansas, by the power vested in it by Article 12, Section 5 of the Constitution of the State of Kansas hereby elects to and does exempt itself and make inapplicable to it the provisions of K.S.A. 15-209 which applies to this city, but is part of an enactment which does not apply uniformly to all cities, insofar as said statute requires that the all appointed officers meet certain residency requirements..

Section 2. The governing body of the City of PAWNEE ROCK, Kansas shall be qualified electors of said city.

Section 3. City employees and officers appointed pursuant to K.S.A. 15-204 may be non-residents of said city, but shall be qualified electors of Barton County, Kansas or qualified electors of any other county if said employee or officer reside within 25 miles of the City of Pawnee Rock; provided, however, that the city judge or city attorney may be a resident of any county adjoining Barton County.

Section 4. This Charter Ordinance shall be published once each week for two consecutive weeks in the official city newspaper.

Section 5. This Charter Ordinance shall take effect 61 days after the final publication unless a sufficient petition for a referendum is filed, requiring a referendum to be held on the ordinance as provided by Article 12, Section 5, Subsection (c)(3) of the Constitution of the State of Kansas, in which case this charter Ordinance shall become effective upon approval by the majority of the electors voting thereon.

Passed by the Governing Body, not less than two-thirds of the members elect voting in favor thereof, this 18<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2008.

#### **CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. 4**

A CHARTER ORDINANCE REPEALING CHARTER ORDINANCE 1 EXEMPTING THE CITY OF PAWNEE ROCK FROM THE PROVISIONS OF K.S.A. 15-204 REGARDING DUTIES OF A TREASURER OF THE CITY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF PAWNEE ROCK , KANSAS:

Section 1. The City of PAWNEE ROCK, Kansas, by the power vested in it by Article 12, Section 5 of the Constitution of the State of Kansas, by duly authorized authority of the Council in 2004, by Charter Ordinance 51, exempted itself from the Requirements of the use of a treasurer for the city, assigning the treasurer's duties to the city clerk.

Section 2. Said Charter Ordinance No. 51, is hereby repealed.

Section 3. This Charter Ordinance shall be published once each week for two consecutive weeks in the official city newspaper.

Section 4. This Charter Ordinance shall take effect 61 days after the final publication unless a sufficient petition for a referendum is filed, requiring a referendum to be held on the ordinance as provided by Article 12, Section 5, Subsection (c)(3) of the Constitution of the State of Kansas, in which case this charter Ordinance shall become effective upon approval by the majority of the electors voting thereon.

Passed by the Governing Body, not less than two-thirds of the members elect voting in favor thereof, this 18th day of June, 2008.

#### **CHARTER ORDINANCE No. 5**

A CHARTER ORDINANCE REPEALING CHARTER ORDINANCE 266 EXEMPTING THE CITY OF PAWNEE ROCK FROM THE PROVISIONS OF K.S.A. 15-106 REGARDING QUORUM REQUIREMENTS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF PAWNEE ROCK , KANSAS:

Section 1. The City of PAWNEE ROCK, Kansas, by the power vested in it by Article 12, Section 5 of the Constitution of the State of Kansas, by duly authorized authority of the Council in 1997, exempted itself from the Quorum Requirements of law.

Section 2. Said Charter Ordinance No. 266, is hereby repealed.

Section 3. This Charter Ordinance shall be published once each week for two consecutive weeks in the official city newspaper.

Section 4. This Charter Ordinance shall take effect 61 days after the final publication unless a sufficient petition for a referendum is filed, requiring a referendum to be held on the ordinance as provided by Article 12, Section 5, Subsection (c)(3) of the Constitution of the State of Kansas, in which case this charter Ordinance shall become effective upon approval by the majority of the electors voting thereon.

Passed by the Governing Body, not less than two-thirds of the members elect voting in favor thereof, this 18<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2008.
