ORDINANCE NO. 326

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING UTILITIES; CONCERNING WATER PAYMENTS; CREATING A WATER RECONNECTION FEE; AMENDING SECTION 15-215 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Governing Body of the City of Pawnee Rock, Kansas:

SECTION 1: Section 15-215 of the 2011 Revised Code of the City of Pawnee Rock is hereby amended to read as follows:

15-215. DISCONNECTION, RECONNECTION CHARGE. The governing body shall establish, by ordinance, a water service disconnection and reconnection charge. Whenever the city receives a request from a customer for termination of water service the disconnection charge shall be added to the customer's final bill. Any service disconnected for nonpayment of delinquent bill shall be reconnected only upon payment of the delinquent bill, interest penalty thereon, and a sixty dollar (\$60.00) water reconnection fee. \$30.00 penalty. (Ord. 267; Code 2011)

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official city newspaper of the City of Pawnee Rock, Kansas or from and after the city complies with K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 12-3007(b).

SECTION 3: Prior section 15-215 is hereby repealed.
