ORDINANCE NO. 339

AN ORDINANCE SETTING THE MINIMUM NUMBER OF SIGNATURES NEEDED FOR A NOMINATING PETITION TO RUN FOR CITY ELECTIVE OFFICE IN PAWNEE ROCK.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Governing Body of the City of Pawnee Rock, Kansas:

Section 1. PURPOSE. Two methods are used for citizens who want to run for city council of Pawnee Rock in upcoming city elections: (a) file a declaration of candidacy on a form furnished by the county election officer, or (b) file a nominating petition with the names of residents of the city of Pawnee Rock on the petition.

Section 2. NUMBER. The nomination petition for any elective office in the city of Pawnee Rock must be signed by at least three qualified electors of the City.

Section 3. EFFECTIVE. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official city newspaper of the City of Pawnee Rock, Kansas or from and after compliance with K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 12-3007(b).
